

Mathematics

Place Value - Counting in steps of 2, 3 and 5 from 0 and in 10s from any number. To recognise the value of each digit in a 2-digit number. To identify, represent and estimate numbers using different representations including the numberline. Compare and order numbers using $<$ $>$ and $=$. To use place value and number facts to reason and solve problems.

Addition and subtraction - To recall and solve + and - facts to 20 and use related facts to 100. To show that the addition of any numbers can be done in any order but in subtraction it cannot. To + and - numbers using objects, pictorial representations and mentally including 2 digit numbers, tens and three 1-digit numbers. To recognise the inverse relationship between + and - and to solve problems with + and - using all the methods taught.

Measurement - Choose and use appropriate standard units to estimate and measure length/height in any direction (m/cm) and mass (kg/g) to the nearest appropriate unit, using rulers and scales.
